

## Minutes of Leadership Meeting – January 18, 2022

Devices for students – We have 55 devices for students as of today. If we go remote, all of our students will have devices.

Math Competition Winners – Mr. Anumanpuram had students sign up for a Math Competition which was virtual. We had 4 teams, which consisted of 11 students compete in the tournament. We had 3 – 7<sup>th</sup> grade teams and 1- 8<sup>th</sup> grade team. Two of our 7<sup>th</sup> grade teams placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the team competition and the 8<sup>th</sup> grade team won 1<sup>st</sup> place in the team competition. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade students received individual awards, 1 – 1<sup>st</sup> place, 1 – 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 6 students – 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade students came in 1, 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. All 11 students will compete in the Math National Championship in May 2022.

Marking Period ends on January 28, 2022 and Report cards will be on the student accounts on January 31, 2022.

New Business –

Starting January 24<sup>th</sup>, we will have virtual tours for students in District 14. 8 will be for individual schools and 2 in February. The Principals of the elementary schools have received the links for their schools to attend.

Ramapo – is an outside counseling agency contracted with the DOE. They are onsite at our school and will be hosting a virtual workshop in regards to recognizing and dealing with trauma.

The PTA would like to have a teacher appreciation breakfast. We would need to find out what the COVID requirements would be in order to have one.

An 8<sup>th</sup> grade Senior BBQ outdoors was suggested. The Superintendent suggested contacting a company to cover the gym floor so our gym floor would not be ruined. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade Guidance Counselor, Ms. Caba has been reaching out to parents regarding High Schools.

It was also suggested that a zoom meeting be held for parents to go over the COVID Protocols. Our Afterschool programs are well attended. All in house sports program attendees (students) are required to be vaccinated. If any games are going to be held, we would require the students to have a COVID test prior to the game.

I-ready assessments are being done. The afterschool recovery program will start up again next Tuesday, and will be every Tuesday and Wednesday. We will also have it on Saturdays. Teachers recommend the students who are struggling to attend this program. This program will run until Mid-Winter Recess and then restart up in March 2022.
